Mission and objectives

Paris Jourdan Economics, backed by the PSE foundation, aims to build a world-renowned department of economics. Its members conduct research over a broad range of fields in the economic sciences, including international trade, micro-economic theory, development economics, economic history, environment economics and regulation, behavioural economics, macroeconomics, public economics, and labour economics. They also explore economics at the borders of other disciplines such as history, the cognitive sciences, and health. PjSE researchers apply a wide spectrum of methodologies in their combinations of theoretical and applied research, and experimental and survey data.







All are deeply involved in the teaching of Masters and doctoral courses and in PhD supervision; members of the PJSE aim to provide top-level teaching in programmes that are open to the world. Researchers contribute through the Institute for Public Policy to the assessment of public policies, and maintain a close collaboration with J-Pal Europe in the evaluation of development policies, thus applying their scholarly expertise to socially useful ends.
