

What is OFE?

Farmer-centric On-Farm Experimentation (OFE) is a pathway toward improving agri-food systems.

OFE combines the **knowledge of farmers and experts** to create **valuable insights** that are **directly relevant to farm managers**. It is a practical and adaptable mechanism to bridge the interests of farmers, researchers and other stakeholders that has the potential to transform research and innovation in agriculture.


OFE is emerging largely independently across the world, reflecting a change in agricultural research that is only starting to be recognised: the need for decentralised, inclusive, grassroot science to **engage farmers** and foster end-user innovation.



A key to OFE success is **flexibility**: the realisation of OFE principles varies with local circumstances, objectives and resources. The **diversity** of OFE initiatives provides opportunities to learn from solutions found in varied contexts.

Conference priorities:

- To share global experiences of farmer-centric OFE
- To explain OFE innovation process as an alternative RD&E pathway for change
- To identify mechanisms for digital applications, scaling and OFE institutional uptake



The 4 online pre-conference webinars will prepare the ground for each theme, providing opportunities to discuss key directions and propose preliminary recommendations.
